## No Pass/No Drive

### **Option 1:** Submit a statement to your local circuit court clerk

This is the information that you need to provide to your local circuit court clerk:

"My child, **[child's full name]**, is successfully participating in a private home school program as defined in KRS 159.051 and KRS 159.030. I, **[parents full name]**, am **[child's name]** parent and I reside at: **[address]**. **[Child's name]** social security number is: **[Insert number]**.

**[Insert date and your signature]"**

Please make sure that you have included in this statement all of the following:

1. Applicant's full name;
2. Social Security or driver's license number;
3. Parent or guardian's full name, address, and signature;
4. Statement executed within the preceding sixty (60) days that the minor is successfully participating in home school as defined in KRS 159.051; and
5. Date the statement was executed.

Along with the above information, bring a copy of 601 KAR 13:070 with you. I would highlight all of (d), starting on the first page. You may want to bring along KRS 159.051 (the actual statute , but you really shouldn't need this.

If the clerk contacts the Transportation Cabinet they may inform you that they must have the verification form (Option 2). Show them the law, but if they remain firm please let HSLDA know. While we will contact the Transportation Cabinet you may need to move to Option 2.

### **Option 2:** Obtain the School Compliance Verification for Driver Licensing form from your local School District.

You may also obtain the Transportation Cabinet verification form from your local school district. The school district should not require anything more than verifying that you have submitted your notice that you are homeschooling your children. If there are any other conditions for you to obtain this form from the public school, please contact HSLDA.
